## Vocabulary Parade is coming!

In the lead up to book week we wish to celebrate our love of words and reading so we are asking children to take part in a vocabulary parade on Friday the 28th of February. Simply, each child will select a word that will become a costume.

- 1) **PLAN** Think of a word '...' that would have an interesting costume design. Unusual words and words that perhaps you may not understand the meaning of would be great.
- 2) **CREATE** You can recycle all sorts of items around your home to make a creative homemade costume: boxes, fabric, tin foil etc.
- 3) MAKE A VOCABULARY CARD/LABEL Remember to make a card or sign with your chosen word on it, so we'll know which word you represent.
- 4) **COME PREPARED** wear your costume to school on Friday the 28th of March. Each class will parade around the hall/playground and best efforts will be recognised.

Over the half term holiday and during the week after, children can plan and make their costumes. A 'Costume design sheet' is attached to the back of this newsletter to help your child plan his/her costume. We have included some examples below. ## ATTENDANCE


Well done to classes 2, 5, 6, 8, 10, 11 and 12 for achieving over 96% attendance last week.
