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Dear Parent/ Guardian,

Following the COVID 19 Pandemic, all schools are required to follow the Government guidelines detailed below:

'Schools must develop remote education so that it is integrated into school curriculum planning. Remote education may need to be an essential component in the delivery of the school curriculum for some pupils, along-side classroom teaching, or in the case of a local lockdown. All schools are therefore expected to plan to ensure any pupils educated at home for some of the time are given the support they need to master the curriculum and so make good progress.'

All lessons will be taken from either the Oak Academy, as recommended by the Government, White Rose Maths, or hand made by our staff to compliment the curriculum that would otherwise be being taught. Work will be set through Class Dojo, anyone without access to the internet can request equivalent paper work from school. We advise using Class Dojo as your child's work can be shared with their teacher and feedback and points given which will increase motivation and achievement.
