Please note that the open days have been replaced by virtual tours, available on individual secondary school websites.

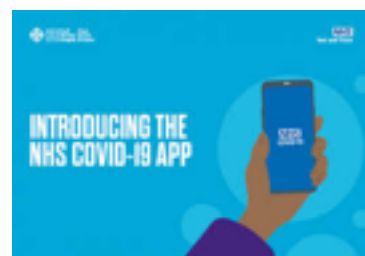

### NHS COVID - 19 App



#### Get ready for the NHS COVID-19 App

On Thursday 24 September the new NHS COVID-19 App will launch – an important tool in stopping the spread of coronavirus. The app has several features including:

**Trace:** Get alerted if you've been near other app users who have tested positive for coronavirus


**Alert:** Lets you know the level of coronavirus risk in your postcode

**Check-in:** Get alerted if you have visited a venue where you may have come into contact with coronavirus

**Symptoms:** Check if you have coronavirus symptoms and see if you need to order a free test

**Test:** Helps you book a test and get your result quickly

**Isolate:** Keep track of your self-isolation countdown and access relevant advice
